ULTRASOUND MACHINE UPDATE

Thanks to the generosity of Knights from across Kansas, the effort to place an ultrasound machine in the Wyandotte Pregnancy Center in K.C., Kan., is moving forward. Approximately \$19,000 has been paid or pledged in just a few weeks. A total of \$26,719 needs to be collected before the state council can request the other half of the funds from the Supreme Council.

Note on the memo line it's for the ultrasound machine. Individuals making a donation will receive a receipt for their taxdeductible donation from the Wyandotte Pregnancy Center.

It's the hope of the Knights this effort will be successful and will be repeated in other areas of the state.
